



## QIKtest

*Ever wonder how your brain is working?*

### **What is the QIKtest?**

The QIKtest is a stand-alone Continuous Performance Testing (CPT) device used for obtaining snapshots of your brain processes. The QIKtest provides your Neurofeedback Specialist with valuable information that helps them determine which site(s) should be focused on throughout treatment.

The QIKtest provides information on sustained attention, impulse control, speed of response, and consistency of response. This information is particularly valuable for individuals diagnosed with ADHD, but can be useful for other individuals as well!

### **How does the QIKtest work?**

The QIKtest collects continuous, real-time data based on how quickly and accurately an individual responds to visual cues presented on the CPT device. A simple visual target or non-target is presented once every two seconds. During the 21-minute test, the subject must press a button to respond to each target and not press for each non-target.

Your Neurofeedback Specialist will provide instructions and a practice test before running the full test. This will ensure you are clear on when to press and not press the button on the QIKtest.

### **When will I see the results?**

Results are sent to your Neurofeedback Specialist immediately after the test has ended. Your Neurofeedback Specialist may need some time to review the data and draw conclusions regarding treatment, but you will be able to receive a printout or e-mail copy of your QIKtest results the same day.

### **What does it cost?**

The QIKtest only costs \$30 for the first test, which obtains the baseline for your brain processes. All future tests are included in this one-time cost as well, providing you with accurate snapshots of brain activity throughout treatment!
